Methodology


The September 2023 Clarity Omnibus Survey was conducted from September 20-25th, 2023 via national online public opinion panels and 1,062 respondents were matched to the voter file. The margin of error of this poll is +/- 1.86% at a 95% confidence interval.

Attention checks were employed in the survey and respondents who failed attention check questions were removed from the sample.


Responses are weighted to a national universe of likely voters using factors including age, gender, race, education, and geography.




Generally speaking, how much do you trust these institutions or groups to act in the best interest of people like you?




Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of...




Given these options, how would you prefer to vote in the next election?




How confident are you that, across the country, the votes will be accurately cast and counted in the next election?




In the 2024 primary election for President in your state, are you more likely to:




If your state's 2024 Republican primary for U.S. President was held today, who would you vote for?




If your top choice [Donald Trump] wasn't on the ballot for your state's 2024 Republican primary for U.S. President, who would be your second choice?





If your top choice [Ron DeSantis] wasn't on the ballot for your state's 2024 Republican primary for U.S. President, who would be your second choice?






If the election were today for the U.S. House of Representatives, would you vote for the Republican or Democratic candidate for Congress?








When it comes to politics, do you generally consider yourself to be a progressive, or not? [IF Party ID w/Leaners = 'Democrat']




When it comes to politics, do you generally consider yourself to be a supporter of the MAGA movement, or not? [IF Party ID w/Leaners = 'Republican']



Which of the following issues is most important to you when deciding who to vote for?













Our Fiscal Progressive Model predicts attitudes toward raising taxes to balance the budget among registered voters nationally. Learn more.


Over the last two years, how often has your household struggled to pay the bills for necessities such as groceries, utility and house payments, or unexpected expenses like car repairs?





Do you support or oppose comprehensive gun reform legislation to reduce gun violence?










What is your annual household income, before taxes?




Are you or is anyone in your household an active or retired member of a labor union?



Including yourself, how many people are in your household?







How frequently do you answer the phone if you get a call from an unknown number, or a number that you do not recognize or is not in your contacts? [IF has phone]



How frequently do you check your mailbox and look at the mail you receive?




On an average day, how many total hours do you spend using social media such as Facebook. Instagram, Twitter or other platforms?





On an average day, how many total hours of television do you watch?




Our Low TV Model predicts likelihood that an individual watches little to no TV and is difficult to reach via television advertising. Learn more.

Which of the following best describes your access to online TV streaming services?




Which of the following TV and video streaming services do you use? Select all that you regularly access. [IF Uses Streaming Services]







